**CALL TO ORDER - REGULAR MEETING.**

1. PUBLIC COMMENT – DISTRICT MATTERS. This portion of the meeting is reserved for members of the public to address the Board on items of interest that are not on the Agenda and are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board of the District. Speakers shall be limited to three minutes. It is requested that no comments be made during this period on items on the Agenda. Members of the public wishing to address the Board on items on the Agenda should notify the President of the Board when that Agenda item is called and the President will recognize public discussion at that time. It should be noted that the Board is prohibited by law from taking action on matters discussed that are not on the Agenda. Speakers are asked to provide their name and address.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES. The Board may review and approve the minutes for the Board's August 10, 2022 meeting.

3. DEMAND FOR COLLECTOR'S DEED. General counsel will inform the Board that the redemption period for a parcel sold to the District under a Certificate of Sale in 2019 has expired. The Board may take actions to demand a collector's deed for the affected parcel and may authorize the District's consultants and officers to take such additional actions as are required under the Water Code with respect to demanding, issuing and recording a Collector's Deed.

4. FINANCIAL MATTERS. The Board may review, discuss and possibly approve a variety of matters related to the District's financial status:

A. Bills. Review and possibly approve bills to be paid by the District and/or ratify prior payment of prior bills.

B. Review of Financials. Review, discuss and approve financial reports prepared by Blankenship & Company.

5. MANAGER'S REPORT. The District Manager will report on current District operations and water deliveries. The Board will discuss the current water supply, concerns expressed by landowners within the District and general water supply and district operational issues. The

Board may take action to implement one or more new policies in connection with the District's groundwater supply and well capacity in light of the ongoing drought.

6. DIRECTOR COMMENTS. The Board may discuss other items as permitted by the California Government Code.
